BROOKFIELD CHRISTIAN REFORMED CHURCH is seeking a dynamic Associate Pastor with strong leadership and relational gifts to lead our youth and discipleship ministries. The Associate Pastor will also integrate visitors, new members, and long-time members more fully into the life of our church – and potentially engage on a number of other leadership fronts, from teaching and preaching to administrative and pastoral guidance.

This person will:

- Hold a healthy, Reformed and Biblical view of the Church, and share our vision of an inviting, hospitable, intergenerational, loving community of Christ.
- Embrace our core values of Worship, Evangelism, Generosity, Justice, Community, & Discipleship.
- Enjoy working with people of all ages, with a passion for youth and their spiritual development.
- Display a bias toward action and dedicated work ethic with an eagerness to engage across ministries.
- Teach and/or preach the Gospel in a clear and engaging manner.

ASSOCIATE: This person is responsible to the Lead Pastor and will serve as part of a team with the Lead Pastor, the Executive Director of Ministries, and the Assistant Director of Youth Ministries. The staff will meet regularly to discuss ministry goals, review and assign responsibilities, and set future direction.

PASTOR: This person alongside the Lead Pastor will minister to the entire congregation: Children, Youth, Young Adults, and Adults.

PREACHING: This person is a capable teacher/preacher able to communicate well with people of all ages.

FOCUS: This person will oversee our Youth Ministry programs and devote about one-third of their time here. For the balance of their time, this person will lead the congregation to a deeper and more robust Christian Faith, which will include the following: equipping parents and singles for in-home family discipleship; coordination, administration, formation and resourcing of Life Groups and Fellowship Groups; teach/preach the Gospel; etc.

- A proven ability to inspire people toward a deeper relationship with Jesus.
- A positive experience with the Church.
- A working knowledge of youth and discipleship ministry.

- An ability to work with and lead volunteers.
- Regular church attendance & public profession of faith.
- A Masters of Divinity from an accredited seminary is preferred, as is CRCNA ordination. Experience in an established congregation.
