

Title: Director of Worship Arts

Position Summary: The Director of Worship Arts is a full-time staff leadership position. With a visible and contagious love for the Lord, the Director of Worship Arts must have excellent relational and organizational strengths, musical training, and experience. The person in this position needs to have a firm grasp of SCPC's values, as well as its Reformed heritage, and the ability to align leadership teams and volunteers with its mission and vision.

Key Responsibilities:

- Work with SCPC's pastoral staff to plan and create weekend services and other worship environments where people have an opportunity to encounter the living God through various worship elements (song, sacraments, testimony, art, video, prayer, drama, liturgy, confessions, etc.).
- Discover, develop, and deploy volunteers necessary to accomplish the vision and goals of the ministry.
- Oversee the programming and content of all services, series, choirs, and events (including song selection, video creation/selection, graphics and backgrounds, print media, and other creative elements).
- Oversee the worship and worship technology budget and staff.
