As such, the leader of this ministry area will undertake a unique combination of responsibilities: developing a student ministries program that creates space for discipleship and friendship while also building and equipping ministry volunteer teams for corporate worship. S/he will also demonstrate a desire to engage students (grades 6-12) of all backgrounds, working to integrate them into the life of the church at large.

Candidates must adhere to the theological vision and beliefs of the Anglican Mission in America, including subscription to the Jerusalem Declaration.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Student Ministries:

- Engage students of all backgrounds and parishes (our congregation’s geographic communities within the Dallas metroplex) with a vision of service, study, and fellowship through their teen years.
- Work with the clergy to integrate students into the existing worship, learning and fellowship of All Saints Dallas.
- Develop a dynamic volunteer base for both Bible teaching and small group discipleship to connect students with thoughtful mentoring relationships and spiritual friendships among peers.
- Build student discipleship small groups program.
- Engage students in service teams.
- Coordinate regular youth fellowship events including a yearly retreat.

Volunteer Engagement:

- Build, guide, and equip lay volunteer team such as greeters, ushers, lay-readers, acolytes, coffee/hospitality.
- Develop an organization system to manage and train lay volunteers.
- Meet with congregants to discern areas of giftedness and the needs of the church for meaningful service.
- Shepherd ministry teams through recruitment, training, and service.
